- > **Full Time Teacher/Teacher's Assistant** (8:00am – 12:00pm)
 - Teach the academic content of the class in the mornings.
 - Execute planned curriculum and directly instruct students
 - Participate in a one week training prior to the start date (June 13-17th)
 - Attend Missions Training Meetings on Sundays from 4:30pm – 7:00pm

- > **Kitchen Staff** (any block of time between 8:00am – 1:00pm)
 - Prepare lunch for the day.
 - Serve lunch to students during lunch periods
 - Assist in lunch supervision
 - Assist in cleaning up

- > **Activity Chaperones** (12:30pm – 2:45pm)
 - Accompany children to various activities
 - Supervise children
 - Chaperone and lead group activities

- > **Project Chaperones** (Fridays from 8:30am – 12:00pm)
 - Accompany children to various service projects
 - Plan and coordinate volunteer projects
 - Lead students in philanthropic initiatives and transfer vision for these efforts

- > **Electives Course Instructors** (1:00pm - 2:30pm)
 - Create and plan an electives course
 - Instruct students on an area of focus (arts, drama, drawing, singing, games, dance, sports, etc.)

- > **Drama Team** (7:45am – 10:00am)
 - Plan and perform skits for worship times
 - Oversee and coordinate praise night
 - Create and perform skits for Vacation Bible School

- > **Clean-Up Staff** (any block of time between 12:30pm – 2:00 pm & 3:00pm – 4:00pm)
 - Clean kitchen
 - Clean the classrooms and the overall facilities
